


We currently have access on a trial basis (until July 2012) to approximately 11,000 titles published by Cambridge University Press in electronic format. Subjects covered include all disciplines across science, technology and medicine, as well as humanities and social sciences.

Accessing CUP e-books

1. Go to <http://ebooks.cambridge.org/>
2. If you are working off the campus network click on the **Institutional Login** link at the top right hand side of the page
 - a. Select **UK Federation**, then **University of Aberdeen**
 - b. Click on the **Select** button
 - c. Login using your university computer username and password

Searching CUP e-books

Keyword search

1. Type a few search terms into the **Search** box near the top right hand side of the page. If you want to use more flexible searching, click on the **>>Advanced Search** option.
2. Your search will retrieve chapters of books that meet your search criteria.
3. To link to full text, click on the title of the book, the **Chapter DOI** or the **Read PDF** link.
