## Accessing CUP e-books

1. Go to <http://ebooks.cambridge.org/>
2. If you are working off the campus network click on the **Login** link at the top right hand side of the page and then click on **Institutional Login**
  - a. Select **UK Federation**, then **University of Aberdeen**
  - b. Click on the **Select** button
  - c. Login using your university computer username and password



## Searching CUP e-books

### Keyword search

1. Type a few search terms into the **Search** box near the top left hand side of the page. If you want to use more flexible searching, click on the **Advanced Search** option
2. Your search will retrieve chapters of books that meet your search criteria
3. To link to full text, click on the title of the book, the **Chapter DOI** or the **Read PDF** link
